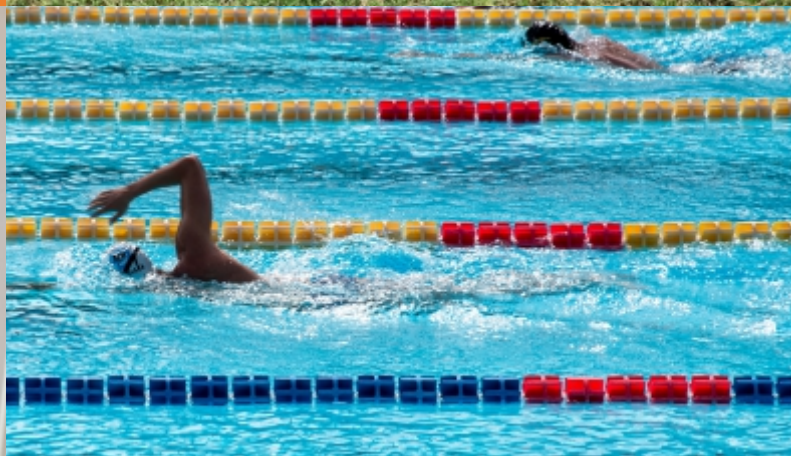
- We have an array of sports facilities including basketball, badminton, swimming, 5-a-side football, self-defence, skates, etc. for all-round development of children's physical and mental health.

- We provide complimentary mid-day meals in the kindergarten section to take care of nutritional needs.
- We furnish counselling and mental health support for all our students.
- We have an infirmary with enough beds, medical equipments and medicines with trained nurse to take care of the students.



TO PROVIDE THEM WITH A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

We understand the concerns of parents when it comes to the safety of their children. That is why we have taken every precaution necessary to ensure the kids remain safe, no matter where in the school they are.

- We have installed CCTV cameras that ensure continuous monitoring of all areas of the school campus.
- The school's fleet of buses is air-conditioned and GPS-enabled so that they can be tracked continuously on designated routes.
- We provide one support staff for every five kids in the kindergarten to take care of the physical and emotional needs of the children. We also provide access to a live-feed of kindergarten classes to the parents.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- The registration form can be obtained either from the city office, the school premises or can be downloaded from the school website.
- For admission to a class, the child must fulfil the above-mentioned age criteria.
- Registration forms are to be filled in and submitted to the school office before the end of the registration period.
- Incomplete or illegible registration forms, without photographs, will not be processed /accepted.
- Dates for test/interviews/interaction will be provided at the time of registration. The school authorities reserve the right to change the date and time of the interview.
- Relevant documents/certificates are to be provided at the time of admission.
- Attested copy of birth certificate will be required at the time of admission.
- For class I and upward, previous year's report card will need to be furnished.
- For class I and upward, a school transfer certificate will need to be produced at the time of admission.
- In case of interstate students, the transfer certificate should be counter signed by the education officer in the concerned state education authority.
- The following documents will also be needed at the admission:
 1. Passport size photographs (3 of the student and 3 of each parent).
 2. Visiting/Business Cards of parents.
 3. Aadhar of parents and students.
 4. Medical certificate.
 5. Death or divorce certificate, in the case of single parents.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT/INTERVIEW

- There will be a written assessment for students seeking admission in class UKG and upwards.
- Results will be displayed on the notice board on specified dates.

Streams offered by School in Grade XI

- (1)Science (2) Commerce (3) Humanities Admission in Grade XI will be granted on the basis of Grade X Board results.

ADMISSION PROCEEDINGS

Successful candidates whose names are included in the list must pay the fees by the dates indicated on the list displayed on the school notice board; otherwise admission will automatically stand cancelled.

- The admit card will be issued to parents only after the form is duly filled and registration formalities are completed.
- Students must report in complete school uniform, along with books and stationery as prescribed by the school on the first day.
